The Pilot Point ISD will involve parents in the joint development of the Title I plan and the process of school review and improvement. (Pilot Point Education Improvement Committee)

An adequate number of parents will work collaboratively with the District Education Improvement Committee in an organized, ongoing, and timely way, in the planning, review and improvement of the Title I program and parent involvement program.

Annually the school will convene a meeting to which all parents of participating students are invited to inform the parents of the school's participation in the Title I program and of parents' rights to be involved. (Meet the Teacher Night, Parent-Teacher Conferences)

Parents will be provided timely information about available programs. (Monthly Calendars, Newsletters, Website, Call-out System, Social Media)

Parents will be provided with the school performance profiles and assistance with interpreting their child's individual assessment results. (Report Cards, Parent-Teacher Conferences, Mailed Information)

Parents will be provided a description and explanation of the curriculum it uses at the school, the forms of assessment used to measure student progress, and the proficiency levels students are expected to meet. (Parent Overview Night, Parent-Teacher Conferences, Student Handbook)

Parents will be provided with opportunities for regular meetings to formulate suggestions, share experiences with other parents, and to participate in decisions relating to the education of their children. (PTO meetings, Campus/District meetings)

Parents will receive a timely response to their suggestions. (E-mail, Telephone and/or Written Mailed Response)

The school will coordinate, provide technical assistance, and other support necessary to assist parents in actively participating in the planning and implementing of a parent involvement program. (Campus and District Education Improvement Committees, PTO and School Volunteer Programs)

Parents will jointly conduct an evaluation of the content and effectiveness of the Parental Involvement Policy and parent involvement program and revise as necessary. (District and Campus Surveys and PTO feedback)

The school shall jointly develop with, and distribute to parents a written Parental Involvement Policy that describes the requirements in an understandable and uniform format. (District and Campus Education Improvement Committees)
