**PPHS Parking Regulations**

Use of motor driven vehicles on school property by students, visitors and staff shall be in the interest of safety, and regulations pertaining to such use shall be strictly enforced by school officials.

1. Student vehicles are required to be registered with the school. **The parking permit must be adhered to the front windshield in the lower right corner (passenger side).**

The following are required to register a vehicle.

- A. Current driver's license
  - B. Liability and property damage insurance
  - C. Completed vehicle registration form
  - D. \$35.00 fee per year (an additional vehicle may be registered for \$1.00)
  - E. No fees, fines, or detention owing.
2. Any complaint of unauthorized entry into a vehicle or act of vandalism will be reported to the Asst. Principal who will initiate an investigative report for the school district, and give assistance in reporting such acts to the appropriate authorities for possible prosecution.
  3. Vehicles without an appropriate pass displayed and vehicles illegally parked in fire lanes, driveways, tow away zones, emergency routes, delivery zones, no parking zones and on lawns, red lined curbs, or any other prohibited parking area will be issued a parking fine, immobilized, and/or impounded at owner's expense.
  4. Drivers are required to observe the 10-mph speed limit on campus.
  5. Areas are designated for student parking, visitor parking, staff parking, and handicapped parking. Vehicles must be parked in the appropriate designated area and display the appropriate parking
  6. The building principal is authorized to establish additional rules from time to time as may be necessary to control the parking areas.
  7. Parking permits may be denied or revoked for cause at the discretion of the building administrators.
  8. Campus Security will issue violation notices for infractions of parking regulations. After 5 violations parking privileges will be revoked.
